About SchoolPass

School Pass is an online tool designed to enable you to:

- Report daily wellness screenings for you child
- Set up a transportation plan for your child
- Manage and report arrival and dismissal changes to the school
- Automatically notify the correct staff, teachers, and other parents when changes are reported
- Self-manage authorized driver lists
- Help the school prepare for an organized and timely dismissal process

Each school configures the SchoolPass platform to fit the needs of their community and establishes policies that support a safe, fluid, and accountable dismissal process. SchoolPass is a tool designed specifically for K-12 institutions and their unique needs. The SchoolPass platform keeps parents and guardians informed and in control, empowering the schools to be able to make confident decisions and ensure their students' safety.

Keep in mind that the help site may show features that you do not have access to. If you have any questions, please reach out to the SchoolPass administrator at your school.

Glossary of Terms



Below are some essential terms used in SchoolPass and links to relevant help articles. Please keep in mind some terms may not show on your SchoolPass account depending on your school's settings.

Carpool

- *Refers to all of the authorized drivers and students in your family. In some cases, this represents drivers and students from multiple families, if families have chosen to merge carpools.*



Arrival/Dismissal Defaults

- *Reflects your child's "usual" routine; revisions to these Defaults after the first few weeks of the school year must be requested through the school administrator.*

"Move to"

- *"Move to" is used when creating a change to your child's dismissal instruction. Examples: Move to Carpool (to move him/her to another person's carpool), or Move to Activity (to move him/her to an after-school activity).*

Move to Student

- *Allows you to send your child home with another student, regardless of that student's dismissal method.*

Move to Bus

- *Allows you to send your child on a different bus or to a different stop for one or more days.*

Move to Activity

- *Allows you to move your child to an after-school activity (such as tutoring, extended care, sports) for one or more days.*

A "Change Notification"

- *When a change is made to your child's transportation plan, a notification email is automatically generated to you, the school administrator, your child's teacher, and the other parent (if you used Move to Carpool)*

Parent User Logging in for the First-Time

Your first-time login can be via your browser or the SchoolPass app. Default dismissal revisions can only be done in the browser version; there is no option to do this on the parent app.

FAQ's

Below are some of the most frequently asked questions by Parent users.

1. How do I add Parent/Drivers to my Parent Account?

The easiest way to add Authorized Drivers to your account is via the SchoolPass App, on the Drivers tab. Read: [Add or Remove Authorized Drivers](#).

2. What is the difference between a Parent 1 and a Parent/Driver?

Parent 1

The Parent 1 is the main parent record that a student is attached to. Parent 1 can be a parent or guardian. In split households with shared custody, each parent can be a Parent 1. (*If you need this to be set up for your family, please contact your school administrator.)

Parent/Driver (Authorized drivers)

A Parent/Driver is an additional parent, and any other person authorized to pick up students in their family. This could be the spouse, grandparents, family friend, caregiver, etc. Parent/Drivers can be added and removed at any time by the Parent 1.

About Parent/Drivers:

- Parent/Drivers who have a valid email address entered into their record may make student arrival/dismissal changes and will also be notified of all changes for that student.
- Parent/Drivers may not add additional Parent/Drivers. Parent 1's can add/delete Parent/Drivers. Parent 1 can add as many drivers as they wish.
- Parent/Drivers entered without a valid email address are on the list of people authorized to pick up Students in that family, but they are not able to make dismissal changes for those Students.

3. If a parent makes a change of schedule in the SchoolPass system, are Parent/Drivers able to view this change from their SchoolPass account?

If one parent user makes a change of schedule in the SchoolPass system, any Parent/Driver who has an email account can view the change in the SchoolPass Parent Student app or website. In addition, students who have access to the SchoolPass app can see those changes on the calendar tab of the app. Read: [Making Student Changes](#).

1. Make sure you've downloaded the SchoolPass App with the car icon.
2. Log out and log back into the app.



3. Completely close the app, and reopen it.
4. Make sure the app is up to date and your phone operating system is up to date.
5. Delete the app and reinstall it.

6. How can I reset my password?

From the SchoolPass App home page, or from your institution's SchoolPass URL, click "Forgot Your Password?" to generate a reset password email.

 You can also email your system administrator at your institution, or support@schoolpass.com.

7. I want to change the email address associated with my Parent Account. How can I update it in SchoolPass?

The best way to do this is to contact your school's administration and ask them to change the email address on file. If you are an authorized driver, and not a primary parent account, you may also ask your family's primary parent to delete and recreate your profile with the preferred email address.

8. I scheduled my child to participate in a school Activity, but plans have changed. How do I cancel it?

Tag Installation Directions for Parents

Note: an institution must make it clear to which side the sticker should be attached. This will vary depending on the layout. [Please read these instructions for sticking the tag to your car.](#)

 **Note:** The tag does not contain any school-related information, only the TagID.

Please follow the instructions below to install your tag on your vehicle. Please make sure the tag is installed on your vehicle before the first day of school to avoid long wait times for you and others in carline. Please inform the school to disable your tag if you sell or replace your vehicle.

Tag Installation Instructions

Most schools require the tag to be placed on your PASSENGER side headlamp, but you may be requested to install the tag on the DRIVER's side headlamp.

		
First On the side of the headlamp, wipe the surface down using an alcohol based cleaning agent. Then wait for the residue to evaporate before proceeding.	Second After the surface has dried, peel back the protective layer off the back of the RFID tag. Prepare to position the tag.	Third Place the tag on the side of the headlamp, press firmly on the tag to achieve a good bond. Avoid pressing too hard on the center of the tag.

Requirements:

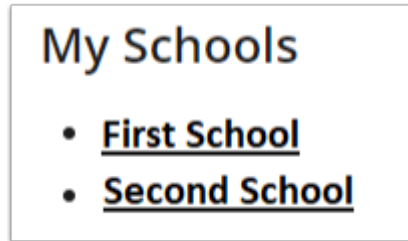
The parent's email address must be the same for all the schools. If it is not, please reach out to the school directly to update it.

Steps

Enter in your email address > Click Lookup

The website will list the schools your email address is linked to.



Open each school link in its own browser tab.

First School: Click forgot password

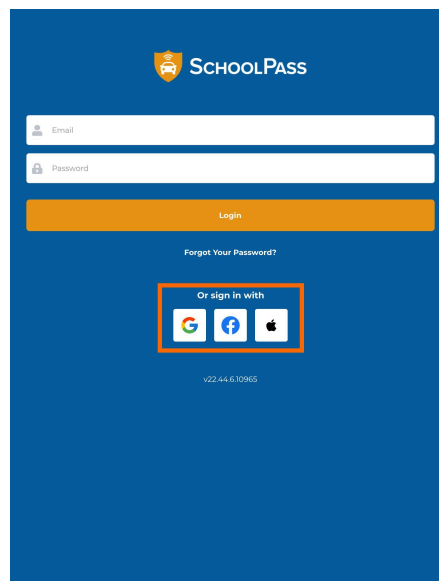


How to download the SchoolPass app

Whether this is your first time logging into the SchoolPass App, or you might be experiencing difficulties logging into the app, please follow the steps below to ensure you have the most up-to-date version installed on your phone, as well as troubleshoot any login difficulties.

1. Take note of which model phone you are using (for example, iPhone 11 Pro or Samsung Galaxy S20)
2. Check if your phone operating system is up to date, and if there's an outstanding update, please download and install it

3. Install or update to the latest version of the SchoolPass Parent App
 - [Download/Update from Apple Store](#)
 - [Download/Update from Android & Google Play Store](#)
4. If you were emailed a temporary password, please enter that along with your email address to log in
 - If you do not have a temporary password, or have forgotten your password, click "Forgot Your Password?" on the home screen to be sent a temporary password.
 - If you were previously having issues logging in, and have just updated your phone or app as recommended in steps 1 through 3, please try logging in again now.

If you have a Gmail address or Apple Mail account registered with your school, you can use the social log in buttons on the home screen to sign into your account directly. Below is a screenshot indicating where you can sign directly in with a Google account.



Should you continue to experience issues, please reset your password on the SchoolPass App home screen by clicking "Forgot Your Password?" and using the email address your school has on file.

- Perform a search in your inbox or spam folder for an automated message from "[SchoolPass.com](#)" and subject line "Temporary Password"
- Return to the parent app and sign in with the temporary password indicated in the email
- Once logged in, reset your password on the "Profile" tab
- If there is no email recognized, contact your school's technical support to ensure that they have the correct email address for you

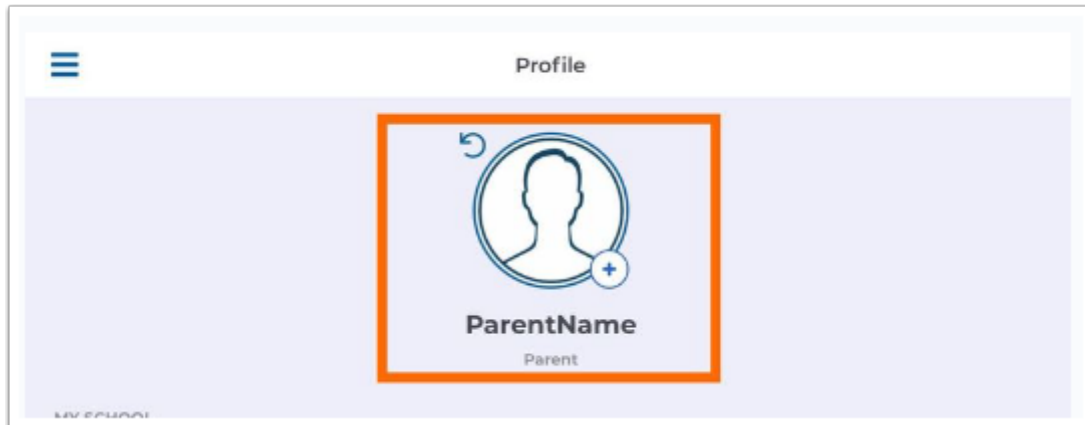


Updating your Profile and Settings

You can update your profile picture, contact information, license plates, password and more via the Profile tab of the SchoolPass App.

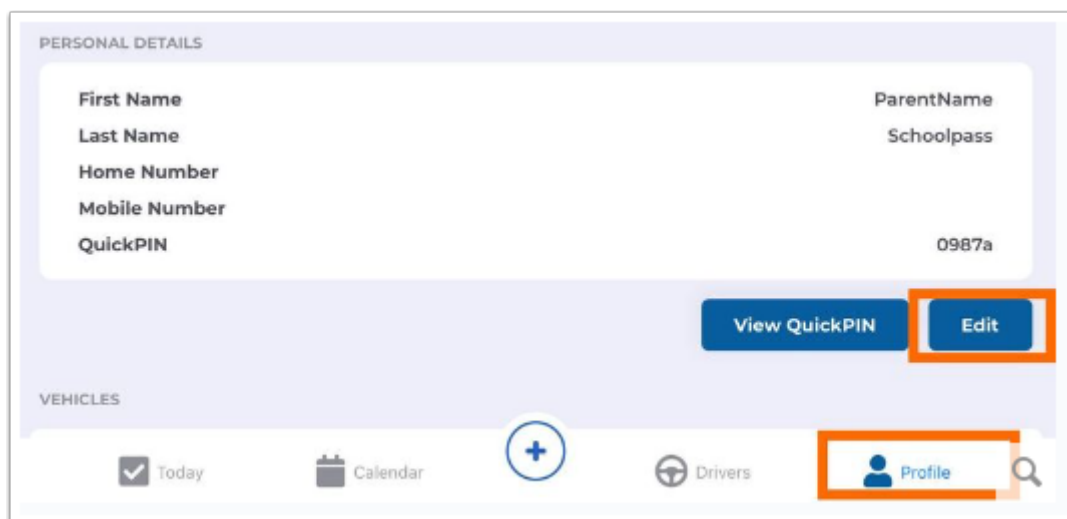
Upload a Profile Picture

To update your profile on the app, click the Profile tab in the bottom right corner. You may choose to take a profile picture directly from the app using the Camera option or upload one from your phone. *Note: please do not upload pet photos as your profile picture; this will appear in car line and across SchoolPass applications.*



Update Contact Information

On the Profile tab, click "Edit" under the box containing first name, last name, and phone numbers to update those. *Note: Please contact your school's administrators to update your email address, as this is likely tied to their student information system.*



Viewing your Quick Pin

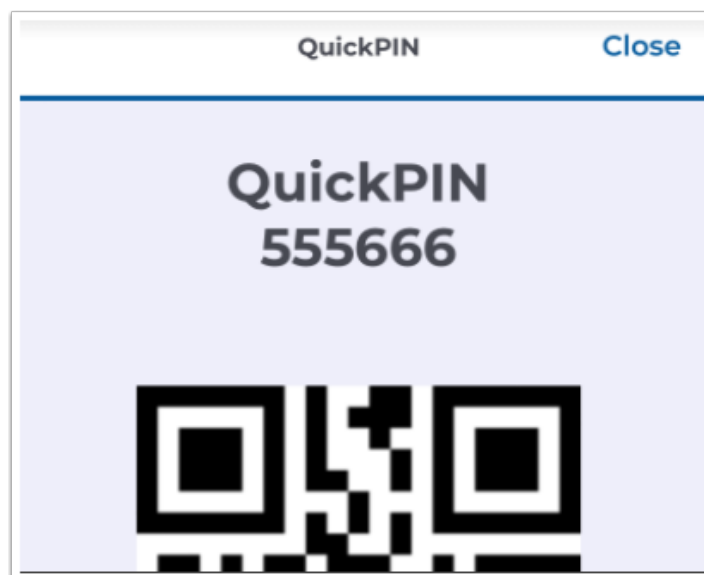
Under Profile, click the View Quick Pin to access your pin and the QR code for scanning when signing in and out of the school.

Add or Edit License Plates & Tags

If your school uses SchoolPass License Plate Reading technology, or uses RFID tag/EZ Pass recognition, scroll to the License Plates & Tags section and press edit.

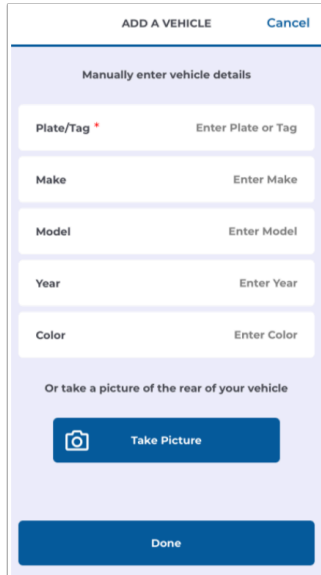
Add in any license plates associated with your account, then hit Save. *Note: You may not enter duplicate license plates, including those tied with authorized drivers. License plates only need to be added once to any driver or authorized driver for the system to associate those plates with a student.*

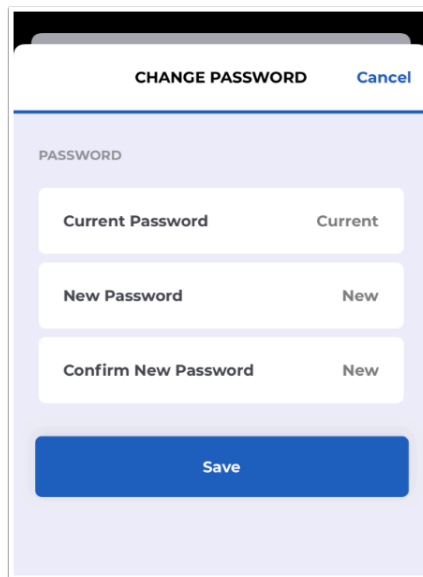

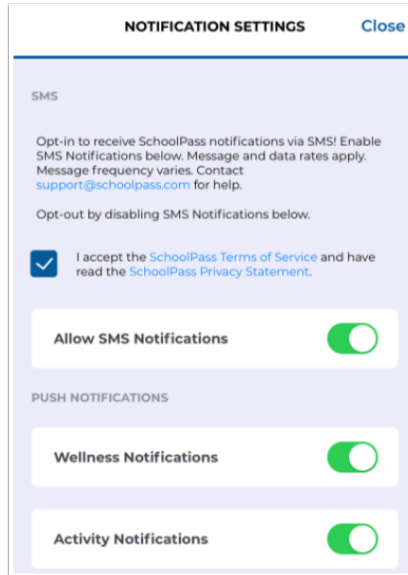
Change Your Password

On the profile screen, scroll to Password and press Change. Where it says Current Password, if you know your current password, type in your current password. If you have reset your password and only have a temporary password, enter your temporary password as your Current Password. Then press Save.



Opting into Text Messages (SMS) and Push notifications

Click Profile > Notification Settings > Click the check box to accept the SchoolPass Terms and Privacy Statement > then click the options you wish to receive text notifications for. Please note if you exit this page then return, the check box to accept will be unchecked however you are still opted in. Emergency text messages will be sent regardless if you've opted in or not.





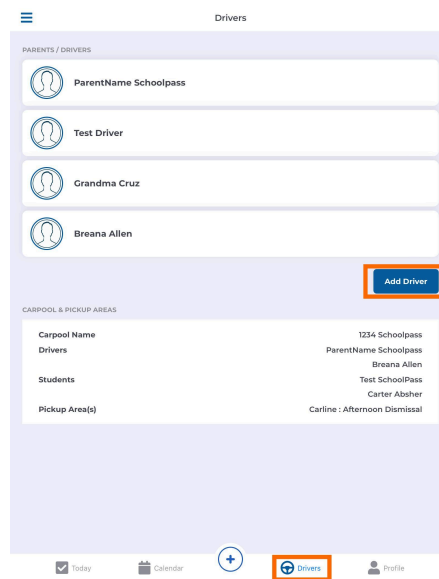
Add or Remove Parent/Drivers

Authorized Drivers are individuals who are allowed to pick up your students from school. Examples of Authorized Drivers include caregivers, relatives, and spouses. If you would like another family at your school to pick up your students, you should use the Carpool option. Please do not list your own students as Authorized Drivers.

Please note: if you do not see the option to add or remove authorized drivers as depicted below, your account is not designated as the primary account holder. Please contact your school's administration if this needs to be adjusted.

Add an Authorized Driver

To Add or Remove drivers, click on the Drivers tab in the bottom of the app.

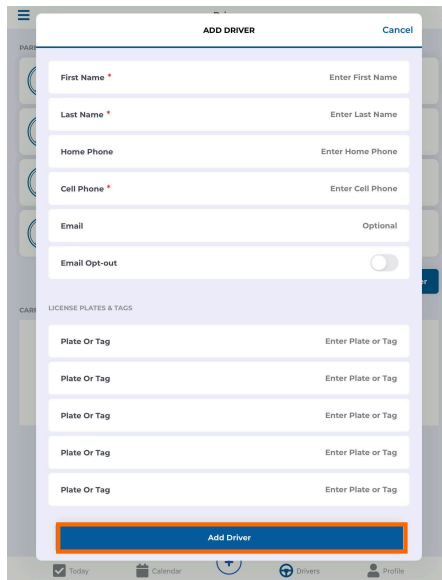


Click the Add Driver button and populate the details of the new driver you want to add.

Fill in all required fields on the Add Driver screen, and any optional fields you may like to include. Should you want this authorized driver to be able to log into SchoolPass, please include an email address. If your school collects license plates, fill in relevant license plate information.

Click the Add Driver button at the bottom of the screen.

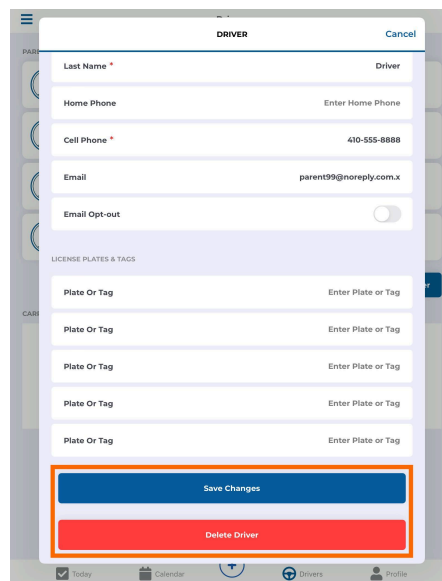
Note: License Plates cannot be duplicates. If you already have a license plate on your account, you do not need to add it again to an authorized driver.



Remove an Authorized Driver

To Remove drivers, click on the driver you want to remove, scroll down and click delete driver.

Scroll to the bottom of the profile and press Delete Driver. This will fully remove this driver's access to SchoolPass. Any license plates associated with this driver's profile will also be deleted.





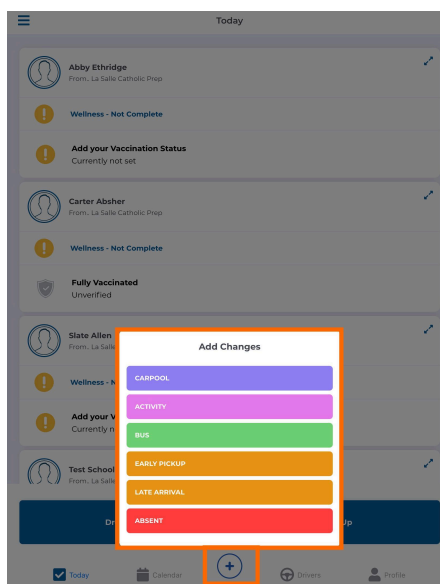
Making Student Changes (absent/bus/carpool etc)

Parents can report carpool changes, activity attendance, bus ridership, early pickup and late arrivals, and absences via the SchoolPass App. If you'd like to add or remove a change to student dismissal plans, please follow the steps below.

Add Arrival & Dismissal Changes

Log into the SchoolPass App and click Calendar to view existing dismissal changes.

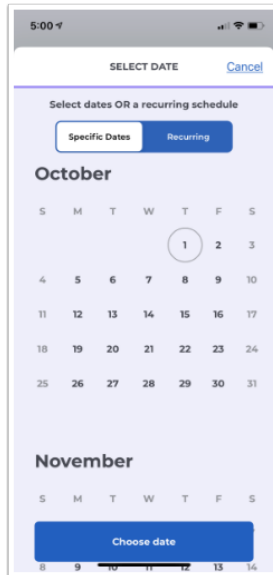
Press the Plus + sign on the bottom navigation to open the Add Changes window. Choose your preferred arrival or dismissal change to continue.



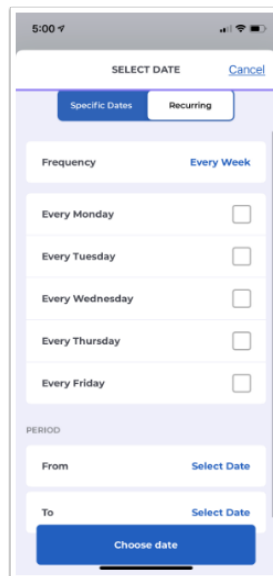
Carpool

Select Carpool from the Changes menu to place one or more of your students into a carpool with another family attending your school. If you already have an authorized driver such as a caregiver or relative registered under your Drivers tab, you do not need to complete this step.

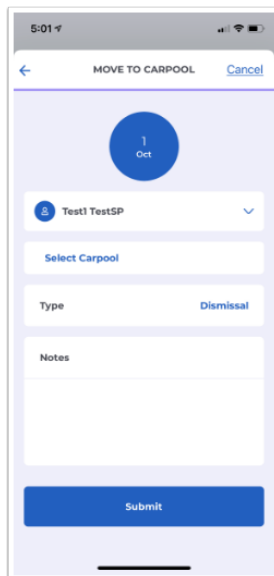
On the first screen, if you'd like to indicate specific dates for your children to join a carpool, select each date on the calendar screen, and then press Choose date to advance.



For recurring carpools, click Recurring and indicate the frequency, day(s) of week, and the start and end period for this carpool. Then press Choose date to continue.



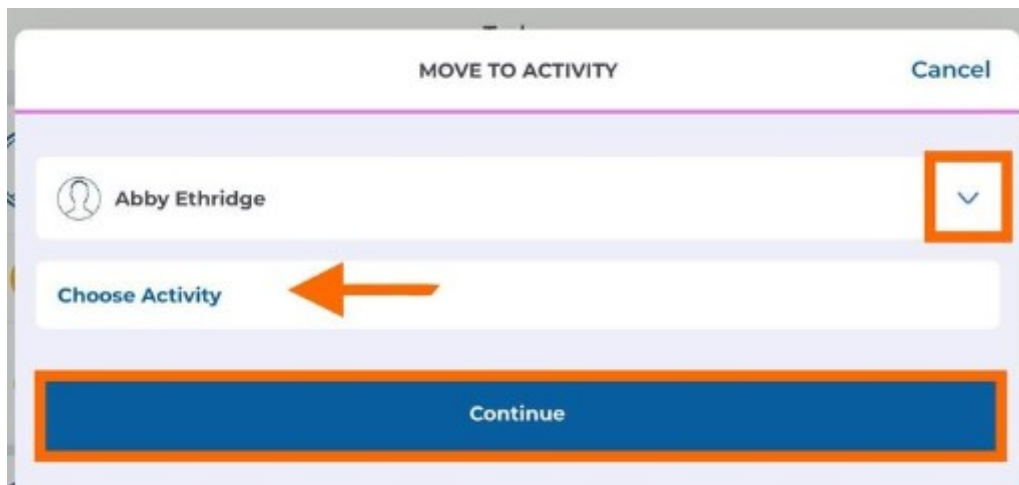
On the next screen, you can select more than one child to ride in this carpool by clicking the drop down arrow next to your child's name. Press Select Carpool to open a window to search for the family you'd like your child to carpool. You may choose to indicate this as an arrival or dismissal carpool using the Type menu, as well as add notes. Press Submit at the bottom of the page to notify your school, as well as the family with which you are carpooling.



Activity

Select Activity from the Changes menu to place one or more of your students into an activity your school has enabled for families. Schools may have activity offerings that cannot be added or removed by families, so if you are expecting to see an activity in this menu but can't find it, please reach out to your school administration for more details.

Depending on the requirements of the activity, you may be able to select more than one student at a time to enroll in the activity by using the drop down arrow next to your student's name. Press Choose Activity, then select from the menu and press Continue.



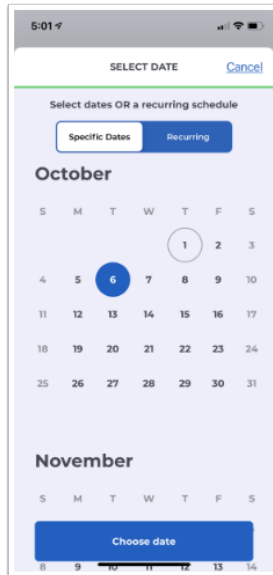


Please note the dates and days of week that the particular activity you are selecting is offered, and indicate the dates you are signing your student(s) into that selected activity. Depending on how the activity is configured, you may be able to choose specific or recurring dates, though these may be locked settings from your school. Finally, press Submit to register your students in these activities.

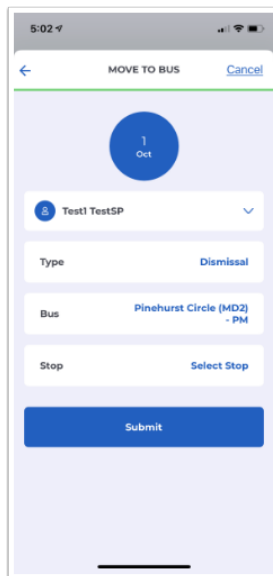


Bus

Select Bus from the Changes menu to place one or more of your students onto a bus enabled by your school's administrators. If you'd like to select specific dates for your student(s) to ride a bus, select the dates on the calendar screen and press Choose date at the bottom screen to continue. You may also make a recurring bus ridership selection using the Recurring menu.

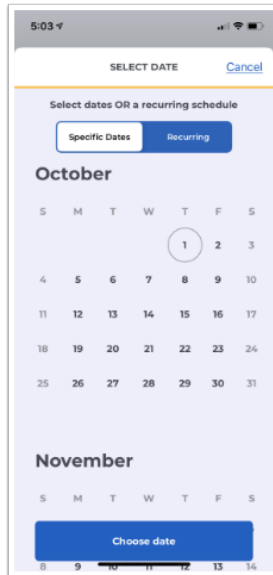


To add more than one student to this bus ridership, press the drop down arrow next to your student's name and select riders. You may indicate this bus as a dismissal or arrival using the Type menu. Finally, select the bus and stop and press Submit to notify the school of your student bus ridership change.

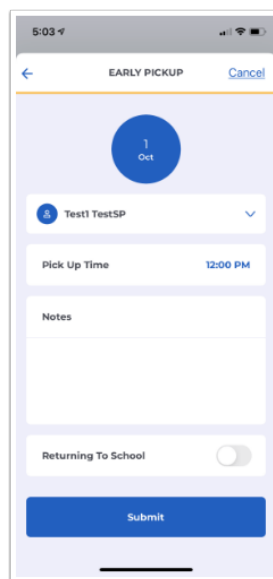


Early Pickup

Select Early Pickup from the Changes menu to indicate dates and times you will need to pick your student(s) up early from school. You may select specific dates or make this a recurring change. We recommend parents contact their school before making a recurring early pickup so that administrators are aware of any additional information.

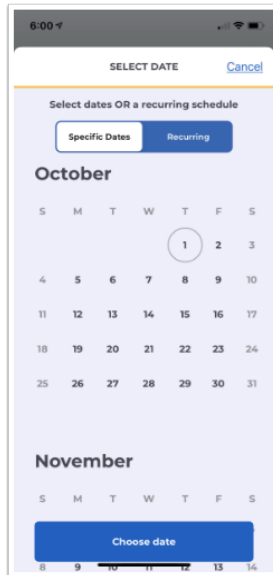


You may select more than one student for early pickup using the drop down menu next to your student's name. Specify the time of early pickup, add a note so the school is aware of the reason, and indicate whether your student(s) will be returning to school on that day. Press Submit to notify your school of this early pickup.

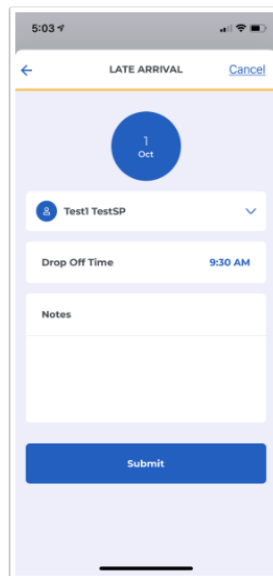


Late Arrival

Select Late Arrival from the Changes menu to indicate a specific date or recurring dates on which one or more of your students will be arriving late to school. Use the Specific Dates calendar to select individual dates, and press Recurring to indicate a recurring late arrival. Press Choose date at the bottom of the screen to continue.

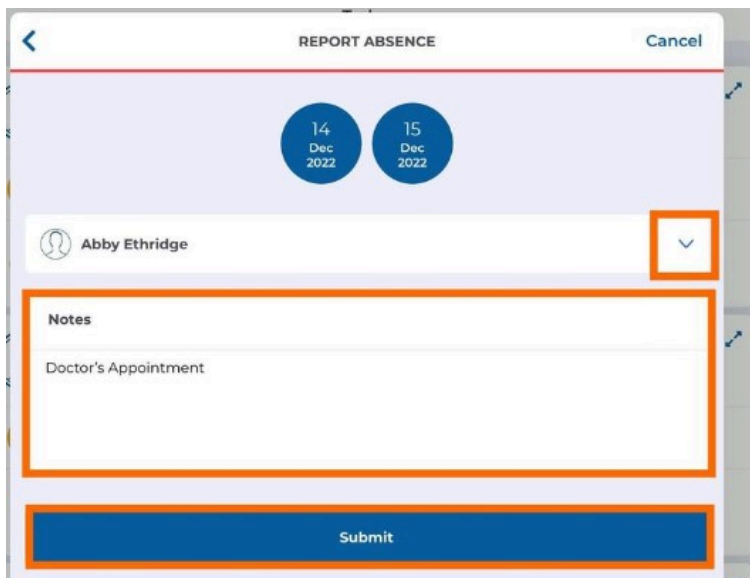


You may select more than one student for this late arrival change using the drop down arrow next to your student's name. Indicate the drop off time, provide a note, and finally press Submit to notify the school of this change.



Absent

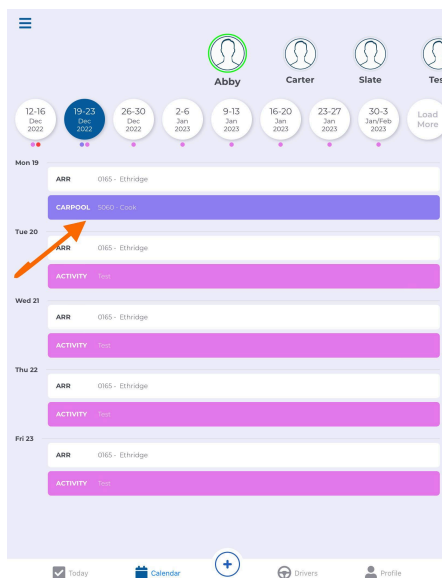
Select Absent from the changes menu to report an absence for one or more of your students on specific dates or a recurring basis. First, choose the specific dates of the absence, or indicate if this will be on a recurring basis. Next, indicate this absence for one or more of your students using the drop down arrow next to your first student's name. Finally, provide a note and press Submit to notify the school.



Remove Arrival & Dismissal Changes

Click Calendar at the bottom of the app and select which child you'd like to delete a change for by scrolling to the left and right at the top of the Calendar screen.

Find the week and day you'd like to remove an arrival & dismissal change for, and press the color block on the screen to open that arrival or dismissal change.



Scroll to the bottom and press Delete Change to confirm removal of this change. Your school will be notified as well as any relevant parties (i.e. in the event of a carpool).

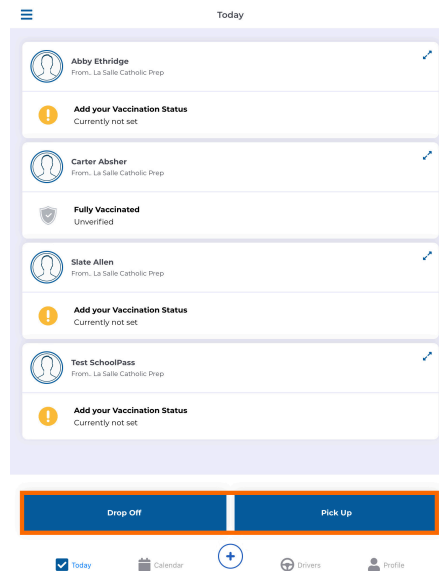

Drop Off & Pickup Buttons (Participating Schools Only)

Note: The drop off and pickup buttons are only functional and visible at participating SchoolPass schools. Please contact your administration if you believe your school is using this feature, and you do not have access.

 If you receive a message saying your student is not eligible, please check that the SchoolPass app has access to your location in your phone settings for the geo fence to work.

The drop off and pickup buttons in SchoolPass app allow parents and authorized drivers to fulfill school requirements for arrival and dismissal, such as providing signatures, reasons for departure/late arrival, indication as to whether a student will return from an early dismissal, and more. Some schools use these buttons as a part of the daily dismissal process, and parents must use the Pickup option at these schools to notify homerooms and administrations that they are in the carline or have walked up to the front of the building, and are within a geo fenced area for dismissal.

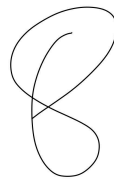
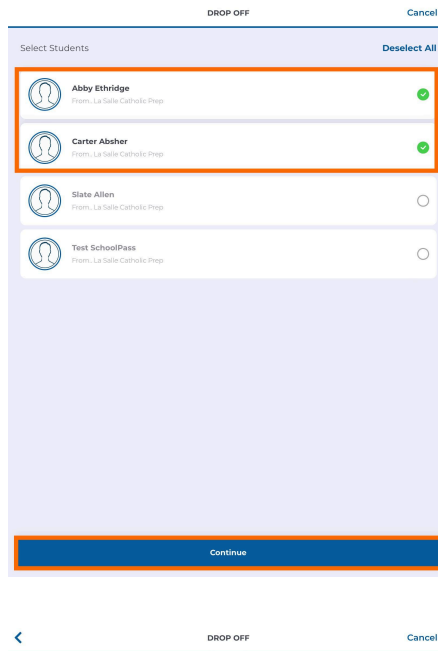


Drop Off

Parents may use the drop off button to indicate that their child is arriving at school. If this is happening early or on-time, the app may or may not ask for a signature, depending on your school's settings. Pressing Drop Off can ask for any or all of the following.

- Reason
- Notes
- Signature

- 1) Select Drop Off
- 2) Select your student/s and click Continue
- 3) Select the reason for Drop Off and click Continue
- 4) Add your signature and click Continue
- 5) A success message will appear

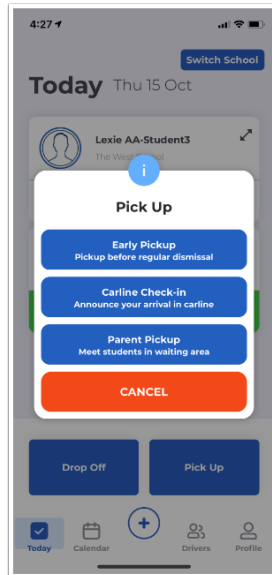


Draw your signature to complete the dropoff process



Pickup

- 1) Select Pick Up
- 2) Select your student/s and click Continue
- 3) Select from the menu if you are doing an Early Pickup, Carline Check-In or Parent Pickup
- 4) Select the reason for Pick Up, check the Will Return box if your student is returning, then click Continue
- 5) Add your signature and click Continue
- 6) A success message will appear



Schools with the pickup button may see one or all of the following options. Reasons, notes, and signatures may be required depending on your school's settings.

- **Early Pickup** - Pickup before regular dismissal
 - Reason
 - Will return?
 - Signature
- **Carline Check In** - Announce your arrival in the carline. Using this button will display your name and the students' names you are picking up for the day in all relevant homerooms, given those homeroom teachers are viewing the Carline page during dismissal. This button specifically indicates that you are in your vehicle and are awaiting student arrival at designated carline pickup areas at your school.
 - Allow SchoolPass to use location
- **Parent Pickup**- Meet students in waiting area. Using this button will display your name and the students' names you are picking up for the day in all relevant homerooms, given those homeroom teachers are viewing the Carline page during dismissal. This button specifically indicates that you are out of your vehicle and are standing in a designated area for pickup.
 - Allow SchoolPass to use location

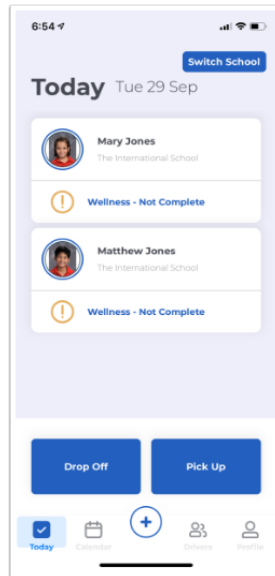


Completing Daily Wellness

Parents and caregivers can complete daily wellness checks for students via the SchoolPass Parent Student App if those students are enrolled in schools that are utilizing the Wellness module. If a school has selected to do so, students in particular divisions and grade levels may be eligible to sign into the SchoolPass App with their own school issued account to fill out their own daily wellness checks.

Please follow these steps to complete your daily screening via the mobile app.

- 1) [Download the SchoolPass Parent Student App for iPhone or Android](#)
- 2) Log in using your email and password, or using one of the single sign-on methods (i.e. Google, Apple ID, Facebook).
- 3) On the home screen, you will see each of your students. If you do not see your students on this screen, contact your school's administrators. Click underneath each student's name to begin the daily wellness screening.



Underneath each of their names, you will see a status indicating one of the following:



Wellness - All Clear

- At the end of the wellness screening, you will see "All Clear" if your answers met the requirements for attending school that day.



Wellness - Excluded



- If you see this status underneath your student's name, that means they are excluded from having to fill out the wellness survey at that time. Should you believe this is in error, please contact your school's administrators to include (i.e. enable) your student in wellness checks.



Wellness - Flagged

- If any of your answers do not meet the requirements for in-person attendance, your student's wellness status will show up as "flagged." Please contact your school's wellness administrators or school health providers for more information.



Wellness - Not Complete

- This status indicates that a student needs to complete their wellness check for the day. Please click "Wellness - Not Complete" to conduct this daily survey.

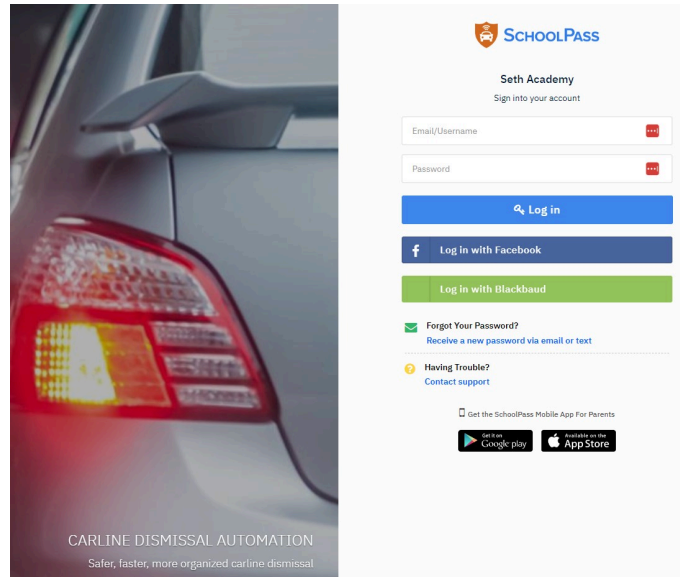

Logging into the parent website

You will receive a Welcome Email from the school with their SchoolPass website link and your temporary login credentials. If you did not receive the email or misplaced it, you can locate your schools website by entering your email in [Find Your School](#). Then using the forgot my password to receive a temporary one. If your email says it's not found, please contact the school directly to setup your account.



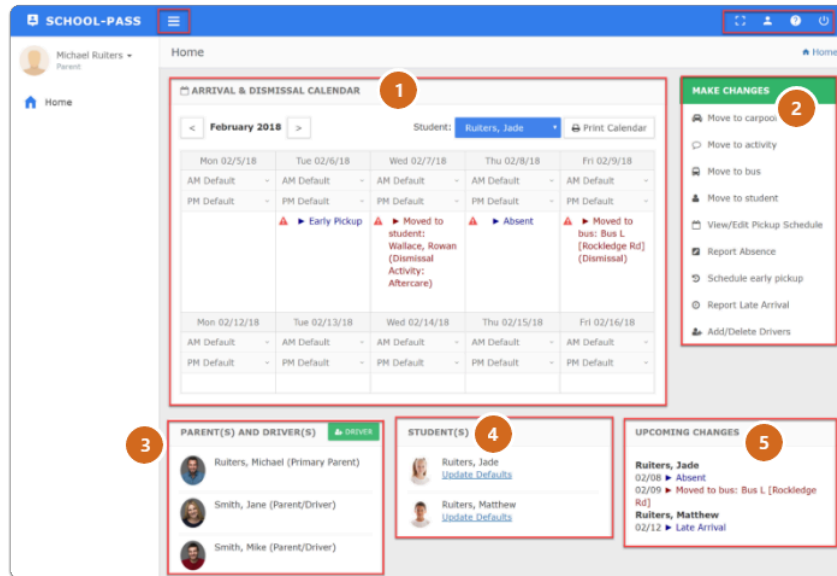
Once on the home page, you may see options such as "Sign in with Google" or "Log in with Facebook." If your parent account is tied with an email address used with these such services, you may be able to sign into SchoolPass directly using those buttons.

If you were emailed a temporary password, please enter that on the home screen along with the email address on file with your school.

Should you have forgotten your password, please click "Forgot Your Password?" on the home screen to proceed.

Set Profile Picture

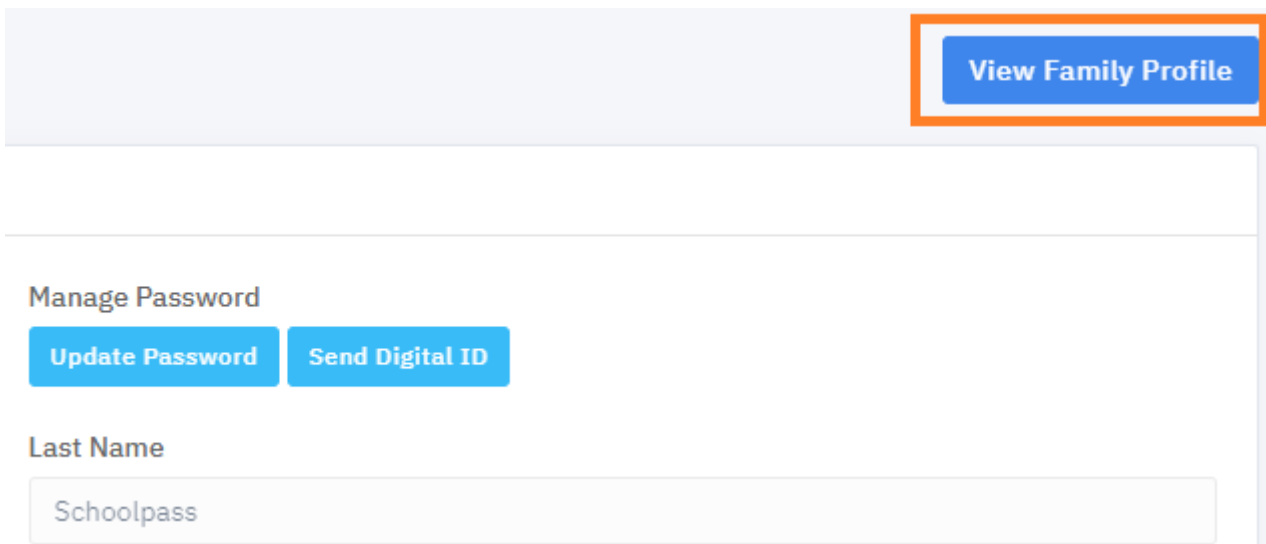
About the Emergency Info *optional*

This feature is only for parent whose school has adopted and enabled license plate / Toll Tag identification for carline pickup and camera security on their campus. Please check with your school administration.

ONLY enter plates/tags for your vehicle.

Your name and profile picture will be associated with the license plate and used for identification by school staff. Each driver in your family/carpool should have a SchoolPass account with his/her license plate attached to that account. Please do not enter all family/household plates under one user account.

Enter in your license plate and or toll tag then click Update at the bottom. Please note you can only enter in a license plate number one time, you cannot enter in the same plate on multiple accounts.

For E-ZPass toll tags, only enter the 11 digits between the two "**".
Example: The number on your toll tag could be: G3B***01600647283***.
Only enter 01600647283 (11 digits) into one of the boxes below.
